

## Trials Methodology Research Partnership (TMRP) webinars

This document briefly outlines the TMRP approach to hosting webinars. Webinars are an excellent way to reach the clinical trials community and are increasingly being used as a method of communication/dissemination.

## 1: TMRP webinar programme

The Trials Methodology Research Partnership (TMRP), along with its five partners, has a 6-monthly webinar programme. Each partner<sup>1</sup> nominates a speaker/topic per month over a 6-month period. This programme is coordinated and hosted by the UK Trial Managers' Network (UKTMN). Webinars are advertised as an entire programme, ahead of the start of the 6 month series, with reminders nearer the time for each webinar. Dissemination of this programme is via the TMRP mailing list and all TMRP partner organisations. The webinar programme is a clear demonstration of the value of partnership/collaborative working and also offers an opportunity for each partner to showcase its own group.

Registration is required in order to event – links to register are provided at the time of advertising. Webinars are hosted on Microsoft Teams, recorded and recordings are then placed on the TMRP website at a later date. Places are usually limited to around 200-250 participants. Brief feedback will be collected after each webinar in order for the series to continue to be evaluated via the TMRP Executive Committee.
